CCCKCSC Member Meeting

March 15, 2008

The club member meeting began at 1:10pm at the facilities of You Lucky Dog in Raleigh, NC. 15 members and 16 guests were in

attendance, which constituted a quorum for the meeting.

Minutes from the November 10, 2007 meeting were accepted as published in the latest newsletter.

Reports of Officers & Committees:

President: Show plans for this fall are coming along well, but we need a lot of money to support the show, so please be generous with donations.

Secretary: The Secretary reported that our fall show had been approved by AKC. Also received was a letter from AKC asking for donations for the Political Action Committee.

Treasurer: Current checking account balance: \$ 2,511.39. This includes One deposit (\$100) of member donations for show expenses, and a \$552.50 payment for design of our logo, and four checks written for show expenses totaling \$1,749.50.

We are estimating our show expenses to be approximately these:

This leaves additional funds needed of more than \$1,600. Our treasury will be greatly diminished after this show if we are not successful in additional fundraising. We have two items at the meeting for a silent auction to raise show funds: a framed print by Yvonne Soereign and a wagon-van dog barrier for the cargo area.

Regional Clubs: No report.

Education: We have just started new classes, Pet Manners/Canine Good Citizen and show handling, Thursday nights at You Lucky Dog. We have 8 students registered, and will accept add ons of anyone interested.

Rescue: Lynn Lake announced that she has had six Cavaliers needing rescue in the last few months.

Membership: One new applications was read: Lin and Laura Osborne (sponsored by Cathy Eason and Dee Wallis).

Newsletter: No report.

Specialty Show: Sponsorships for trophies are being accepted at the meeting or by mail to Gwen Wells or Dee Wallis.

Minutes of the Board meeting
Central Carolina CKCSC
Friday April, 11, 2008

Meeting called to order at 8:00 pm by President, Bill Nelson. Present: Bill, Steve, Amy, Lynn, Dana, Dee, & Cathy.

Minutes for the Friday, February 8, 2008, meeting were read, and accepted as written.

President's Report: AKC has started a new charitable corp: the Humane Fund; it is to be a hall of fame to pay tribute to worthy dogs and allow educational grants; we are invited to give them \$1000 as a founding member and get a plaque. Put off for discussion at the October Board meeting after the Show.

Secretary's Report: None

Treasurer's Report: We have \$3,156.39 on deposit; I have not recorded trophy commitments; waiting to bundle them. I solicited and received quite a few trophy donations at the Charlotte show. Some are yet to be received in hand. We still need to raise a few thousand dollars to cover the expenses of putting on the show.

Committee Reports

Membership: We need to send out membership renewals May 1. We will not change dues this year.

Newsletter: Mary & Darrell Rich are working on the April newsletter. They need information.

Nominating: There were no nominations from the floor at the March Member Meeting, so the Nominating Committee slate will be elected by acclamation at the May Member meeting.

Education:

Classes We have held another set of classes at You Lucky Dog, that end April 17. We raised \$800; paid YLD \$120 for use of facilities.

Show Plans for the 2008 Independent specialty Premium list is about ready to go to MBF. Dana is working with Pat Shatto at MBF. All trophies have been sponsored. Dana reviewed the terms to go into the premium list. We have the opportunity to put the judges up at one of the resort hotels in Pinehurst at a reduced rate. Entry fee: \$28 regular classes; \$25 for sweeps; if a junior showmanship is a second entry of the same dog, it is at no charge. We will not have a parade of title holders, since we cannot afford to offer it at less than the regular entry fee, because MBF fees will apply to these entries, and the ribbons we were considering would increase the cost above regular entries. We will consider putting it at our next years Fun Day.

Old Business: None.

New Business:

DKC Fall Show The Club will donate a Wilton Armetale bowl for Best of Breed (donated to the Club for this purpose by Bill Nelson); and Dana will donate to DKC for the Cavalier trophy fund;

Bark in the Park, scheduled on April 26. We will not participate.



Responsible Dog Ownership Day to be held by AKC in September - We have declined to participate, since we do not have the membership power to commit to it in the weeks after our show.

Exhibitors Networking: Cathy & Amy will find a restaurant convenient to a maximum number of our member exhibitors; Dee & Steve will check on a date in June that does not conflict with shows. We will circulate a notice to all member exhibitors that we want to begin having regular dinners together to exchange information and ideas.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:35 pm.
