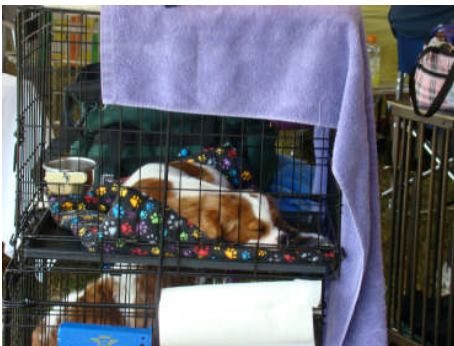

“CAVALIERS OF CENTRAL CAROLINA” SEPTEMBER 2009

Judge Jeanie Montford

My thanks to the Cavaliers of Central Carolina for the invitation to come and judge at your show – I really think it was one of the most enjoyable weekends judging that I have had – a great atmosphere, so many willing workers and great sportsmanship displayed by the exhibitors. Generally the Cavaliers were of a good quality with the major winners very typical of the best of the breed worldwide. I was particularly impressed by several things: in the whole entry there were only about three less than perfect scissor bites (and one of these was a youngster whose mouth should come right with time) This compares more than favorably with a big entry (about 200) I judged in Australia this year where possibly one third of the entry had incorrect mouths. I was also pleased that nearly every entry had the correct dark brown eye – only the odd one or two were noticeably lighter. This is really wonderful but having said that, many of the eyes could be larger – it's the size and placement of the eyes that do much to create the wonderfully soft and generous Cavalier expression. I think the correct sized eye is so rare these days that many people have never actually seen it and they take the current predominantly mid sized eye to be correct, sometimes even referring to the correct eye when they finally see it as being “too big” (as was said to me recently by a Canadian judge) . Head type in the males varied greatly – some “overdone”, some lacking fill and cushioning under the eyes, some with muzzles either too long or too short for the Standard. Heads on the bitches were much more consistent, most having the correct flat skull, high ear set and very typical sweet expressions.

However, not everything in the garden is rosy.....Cavaliers are quite rightly shown in the “Toy” group being a small companion dog. But while they are a “Toy” they need to be sturdy and robust to fulfill their role as active family members. I was really shocked to find that not many exhibits had any muscle development especially in the hindquarters. This indicates lack of exercise and activity and was probably responsible for the truly awful movement of so many. I am sure my co judge who did the sweepstakes agrees with me on this point. The AKC Standard on Gait is very clear “viewed from front and rear it is straight and true, resulting from straight-boned fronts and properly made and *muscled* (my italics) hindquarters”

So many looked attractive in profile on the first circuit of the ring, but when sent up and back they moved very close behind with hocks brushing, even crossing in some cases and tended to “pin in” and occasionally even cross in front when coming back to me. In polite parlance they were “careless with their legs”.



Correct conformation is important in allowing the dog to function efficiently with less wear and tear on its joints and ligaments; correct conditioning is just as important, enabling the dog to have the light and proud carriage that does so much to give that "royal" impression.

The other thing which worried me was the rather small size and fine bone of some of the bitches, something which needs to be watched in planning breeding programs. The Standard calls for "moderate" bone. Many of these ladies will have to carry litters and rear puppies and need adequate resources to give the next generation the correct bone and substance.

Well balanced body, good lay of shoulder and turn of stifle, soft head and expression, correct length of muzzle and nice open generous stop, dark eyes well pigmented, moved a little close behind. BEST PUPPY

2 - **Harmony Juston** By Ch Brookhaven Dream Lover x Ch Harmony Miss Independence - Breeder Glenn Richmond Owner David Worthington & Glenn Richmond

Handsome boy well angulated front and rear, just a little longer in coupling and tended to fly his tail as little on the move. He showed a little bit of white around one eye but not so much as to mar his expression. Well marked coat of silky texture.

3 - **Killbrook Oxallis** By Ch Kilbrok Kiefer x Kilbrok Ivy Green - Breeder / Owner Joann Opel

A smaller lighter boned boy, pretty face but technically a shade short in muzzle. Not quite as well angulated as those above.

4 - **Signacourt The Story of My Life** By Ch Mystic Seeker x Ch Hickoryridge Deja Blue - Breeder / Owner Anne James

A larger sized boy with moderate bone, he was very attractive on the move using his excellent hindquarters. He appeared to be just a little steep in croup, beautiful coat texture.

12-18 DOG (2)

1 - **Grantlley Goodwood** By Salegreen Frederick x Grantlley Moon Lighting - Breeder: R Bidgood / Owner Valerie & John Cromer

Good blenheim, correct proportions of height to length, well angulated front and rear. He moved a little close behind on the up and back but in profile had a lovely easy ground covering stride, carrying an impeccable topline on the move. Pleasing head, nice broad skull, high set ears, has dark eyes but would benefit from being just a little larger, good coat texture.

2 - **Jayba's Moose Tracks at Huntland** By Ch Cinderlace Bramble x Ch Cinderlace All About Sally - Breeder: Pat Lander Owner Hollis & Carol Land & Pat Lander

A lightly marked blenheim again quite a pleasing head and expression complete with lozenge. His eyes could be larger. He was a little longer in coupling and could do with better turn of stifle, moved true up and back.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLED (2)

1 - **Amantra Stagehand** By Wandris Entertainer x Amantra Madonna - Breeder: Di Fry & Tracy Jackson Owner Jamie Adkins & Trish Ohlschlager

Blenheim, correct proportions of height to length, well angulated front and rear nice bone and substance for his size with lovely spring of rib. Very pleasing head and expression, broad flat skull, dark eye with good pigmentation, shade short in muzzle, very good mover up and back. His richly pigmented coat was fairly curly today but with attention to his preparation, this could be remedied – I don't mean trimming (!) just better use of dryers etc.

2 - **Goldenspur Sandpiper** By Ch Twickenham Brookhaven Logan of Mimric x Goldensur Mercy - Breeder/Owner Eileen Gower

Well marked blenheim not in the coat of first, broad skull and good eyes but lacking fill and cushioning under the eye, he needs more padded muzzle. He was somewhat erratic on the move but when he settled went up and back very accurately.

BRED BY (1)

Nice type of dog with good bone and body, good proportions, good spring of rib, short coupled, good lay of shoulder. Head with broad skull, high set ears, dark eyes which could be larger, needs a little more fill and cushioning under the eye, a good mover up and back but tending to rise over the loin in profile. He had the typical happy temperament.

AMERICAN BRED (1)

Smaller and lighter boned, short and compact body, happy temperament moved well wide skull and correctly set ears but showing some white around the eyes. Very lightly marked but what markings he had were very rich chestnut.

Very correct bone and substance, most pleasing head, broad skull with lozenge correct dark eyes, lovely open generous stop, correctly tapered and padded muzzle, well angulated front and rear, moved a little close at times. Richly marked, silky textured coat, gay and happy Cavalier. RESERVE WINNERS DOG

2 - **Loranka's Spend it All** By Loranka's Enchanting x Loranka's Cherished Moments - Breeder L Hughes Owner Patsy Casey
Lightly marked boy who couldn't have a richer chestnut! Again a similar head not overdone in any way, lovely dark eyes, nicely tapered muzzle, well angulated, very accurate mover up and back and covered the ground beautifully in profile maintaining a level topline, showed with great animation.

3 - **Jayba's In Your Dream** By Ch Trulov Kiss N Tell of Jayba x Ch Sheeba Twinkle Star of Jayba - Breeder / Owner Pat Lander
Another lightly marked boy somewhat heavier in head and a little longer in coupling, nice coat texture, well presented.

4 - **Brookhaven Enchanted Quest for TruElegance** By Pascavale Enchanted x Ch Orchardhill Brookhaven Bliss - Breeders Paula Ayers & Erica Venier Owner Valerie & John Cromer\

A heavier marked blenheim with rich red colour. He was a little heavier in head and a bit cheeky under his dark eyes. Could benefit from better shoulder angulation and he was not cooperating well with his handler.

OPEN RUBY (2) Two nice boys for size and bone right in the middle of the standard.

1 - **Stepamgar's Cooper Penny** By Pascavale Stanley x Amantra Indicolite - Breeder / Owner Linda & Jim Shreffler

This outstanding dog really caught my attention - beautiful head and expression, absolutely correct dark round eye with soft melting expression, beautiful flow of neck into correctly laid back shoulders, good spring of rib and ribs carried well back, short coupled, moved so well - absolutely correct topline and tail carriage dead true on the up and back, coat of shining and reflecting the light. Just needs a little more maturity and finish, pushed the BOB winner hard. A well deserved WINNERS DOG

2 - **Lizmere Made in Milan** By Davidoff Perle Du Sahel x Lizmere Eugenia - Breeder /Owner Victoria Gardner

Similar in size, not quite the head and expression of the winner and somewhat reluctant to move today - when he did move, he presented such a nice picture.

Nice well broken up tricolour, good make and shape, lovely neck and shoulders, just a touch long in coupling, pleasant head with lovely dark eye, moved accurately and well, kept outline in profile.

2- **Huntleigh Bizzy Lizzy at Picketfence** By Enduring Adonis x Huntleigh Double Dutch - Breeder Tara Palmer Owner Darla Frey

Lightly marked, a little shorter in coupling perhaps, a very good head with beautiful dark eyes, kept nice topline when moving around the ring, good coat texture. Just need a little time to mature.

3 - **Okayc The Twelfth of Never** By Jayba Pieces of Eight at Southern Knights x Castle Hill Bonnie Blue at Okayc - Breeder / Owner Kathryn Phipps

Not such a rich chestnut as the winner and her head needs to fill and mature a lot under the eyes and fill through the muzzle. She didn't have quite the shoulders of the first two and was a little longer in coupling, lovely personality.

4 - **Huntland Teddy's My Daddy** By Ch Truluv Kiss N Tell of Jayba JW - Breeder/ Owner Hollis & Carol Land

A really sweet little girl, head still has a lot of maturing to do, she had absolutely beautiful eyes - large dark round with good pigment, well broken up markings and she went quite well on the move.

9-12 BITCH (5)

1 - **Stepamgar's Sierra** By Ch Wildflower Jack-in-the-Pulpit x Ch Stepamgar Maria Anna - Breeder / Owner Linda & Jim Shreffler
Nicely balanced, good overall conformation, quite a sweet head complete with the lozenge, she moved very well maintaining the correct outline, well angulated behind, just needs to coat up to complete the picture.

2 - **Castlekeep - Paloma Chiffon** By Ch Cinderlace Bramble x Ch Charterwood Damask - Breeder / Owner M Anderson & D Campbell

This little girl didn't have the lay of shoulder of the first and was tending to rise in topline to the rear, she time to needs to fill in muzzle.

3 - **Nickleby's Amelia Bloomer** By Ch Aranel Renaissance x Ch Rokirk Sweet Dream - Breeder / Owner Mary Walker

Similar size, well broken markings, pleasing head. Would like some more size and bone on these three.

4 - **Forestcreek On a Roll** By Orchard Hill Shirmont Show Off x Ch Mayfields Blue Bayou Girl - Breeder Kevin & Debra Cline / Owner Kevin Cline, Vinton Cline & Mary Helen Cline

A bigger heavier and longer tricolour with attractive head, very dark eye but would prefer a bit larger, would benefit form better lay of shoulder, longer in coupling, beautiful coat of the softest texture.
